

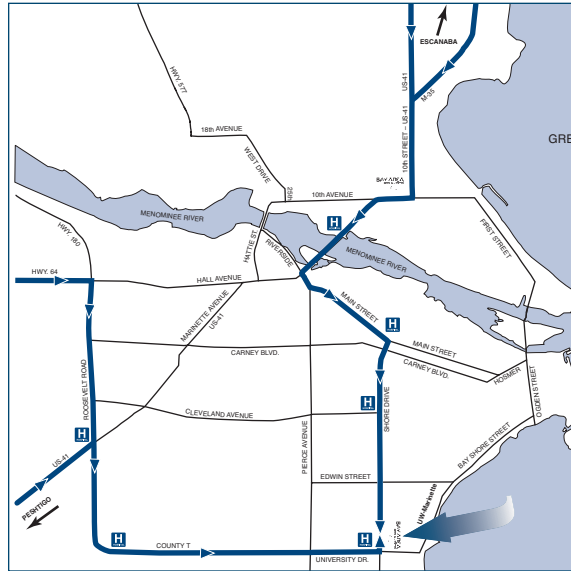


Living Hope Cancer Support Group

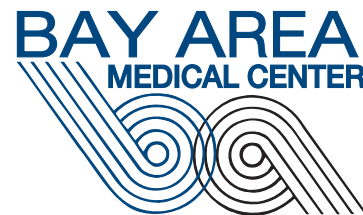
